The Evergreen A's hosted the 7th National Model A Convention held in Seattle, July 1972.

There were 1560 total participants, with 450 cars in the parade. \$,500 attended the car show at the Coliseum. 79 Chapters of MAFCA represented 25 states and 4 foreign countries.

An air of importance preceded the parade of Model A's from Sick's Stadium through downtown Seattle. All downtown traffic was stopped by police motorcycles escorting the cars down Fourth Avenue.

You could hear no engine sounds because every horn button was in use. What a noise, the wails of aah-oo-hahs!

One newspaper said "The String of A's looked like a gangster's funeral."

Evergreen members are still being complemented on their facilities, organization, and presentation of this convention, the last one to be hosted by a single MAFCA Chapter.
